## **SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT**

To either of the Constables of the Town of Bernardston in the County of Franklin,

**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the Bernardston Elementary School gymnasium, in said Bernardston, the 19th day of August next at seven o'clock in the evening, in the year 2019, then and there to act upon the following articles:

**Article 1:** To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Vehicle Stabilization Fund an amount not to exceed \$47,000.00 for the purchase of a new vehicle for the Bernardston Police Department, or take any vote or votes in relation thereto.

**Article 2:** To see if the Town will vote to accept the FY20 budget voted by the PVRSD School Committee on July 11, 2019, in the amount of \$14,154,316 of which \$9,239,616 will be assessed to the member towns and further vote to Raise and Appropriate an additional \$13,619.25 and transfer \$8,355.15 from the Bernardston Elementary School Communications account to fully fund Bernardston's share of the Operating Assessment (\$2,969,574), or take any vote or votes in relation thereto.

You are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting up certified/attested copies thereof at least 14 (fourteen) days before the time of holding said meeting at the 5 (five) places within the town listed below:


